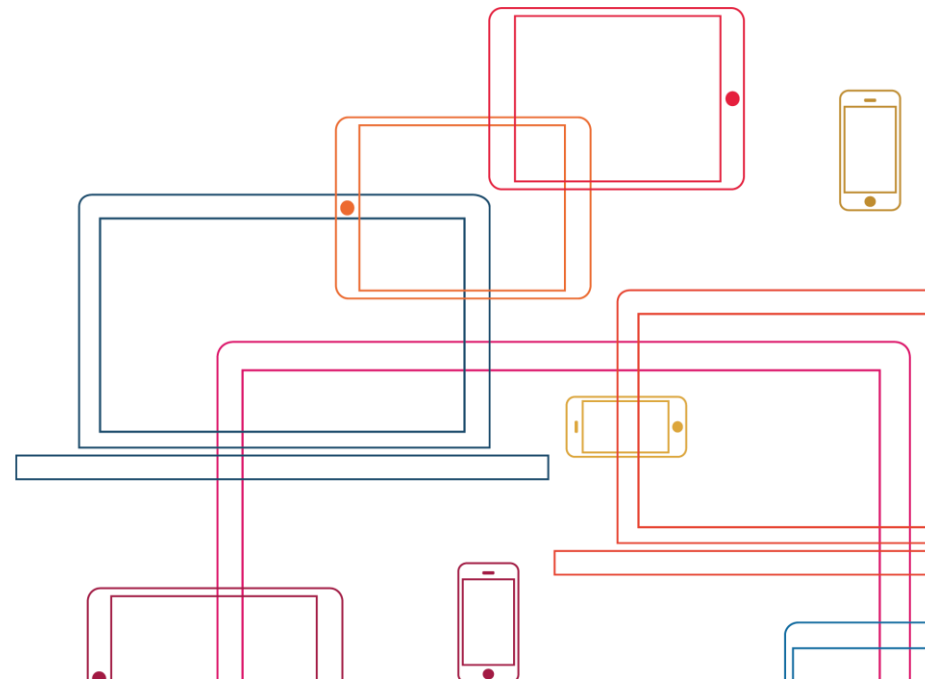

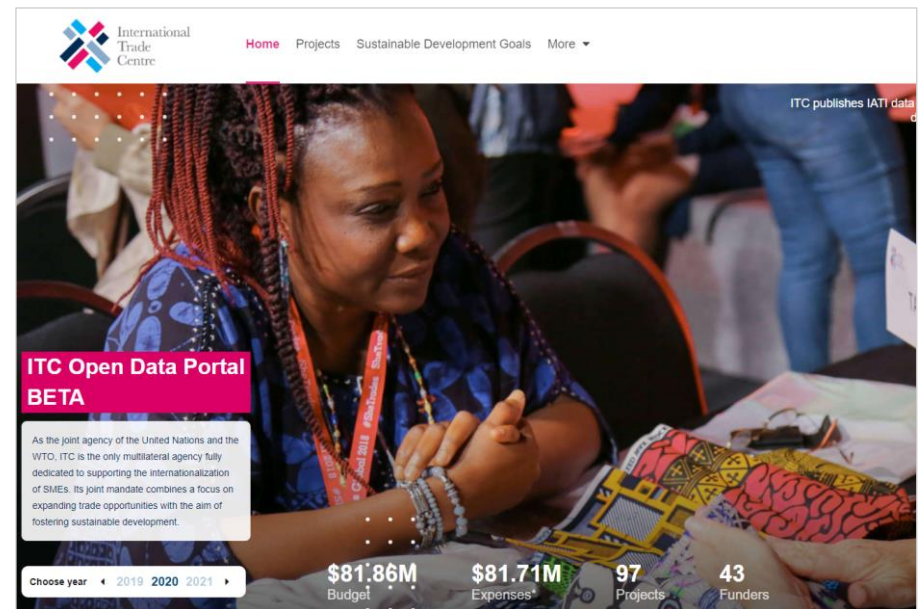


What is IATI

- The International Aid Transparency Initiative is a global initiative that seeks to improve the transparency of development aid spending in developing countries;
- The IATI Standard is a set of reporting rules and guidance to ensure information is easy to access, understand and use;
- Over 1,360 organisations have published data to the IATI Standard;

ITC's IATI data

- ITC has been compliant since 2018, publishing 90% of XB-portfolio by project value (around 100 projects);
- ITC publishes data twice a year and it has been available on the IATI d-portal
- IATI scores its publishers and ITC is ranked in the top 10%

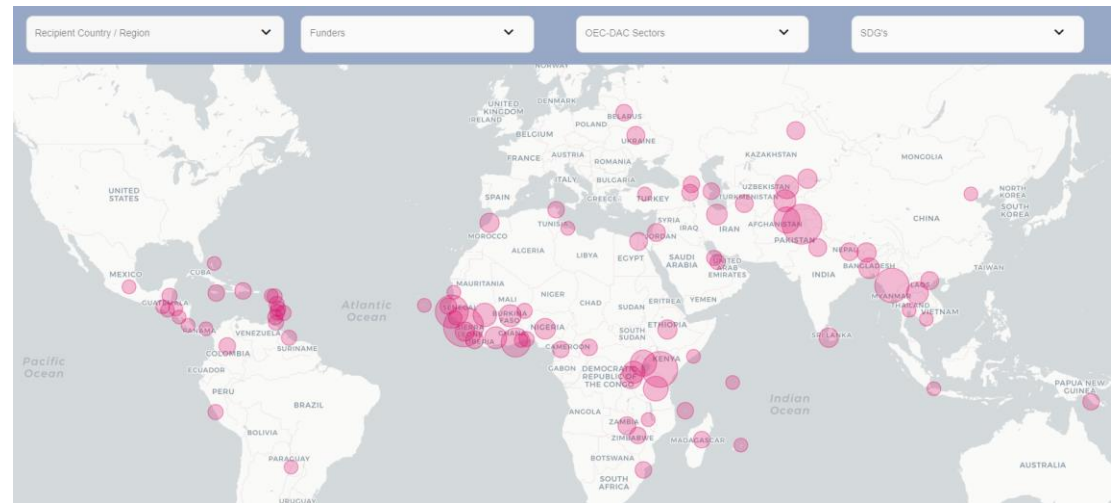
